### Terms and Conditions (please retain for your records)

Moorings will be allocated at the time of the festival. The Harbour Master reserves the right to allocate moorings at his/her discretion.

Anyone leaving their boat unattended prior to the Festival should not use chains in case the craft needs to be moved.

There are no facilities on-site. Please arrive with water tanks full and sewage tanks empty. The nearest water and waste facilities are at Grindley Brook and Ellesmere.

Longer boats arriving via Grindley Brook will need to pass the arm and wind to enter the junction.

The entry fee covers the named boat. No refunds will be made for cancellation or non-attendance.

The named boat must have current licences, including a trading licence where required. Trading boats must also provide a risk assessment.

Third party insurance cover to the value of £1,000,000 (one million pounds sterling) must be held throughout the event.

Waterways by-laws must be observed.

The organisers cannot be held responsible for any damage to persons or property however caused.

You must abide by the directions of Festival Officials at the event appointed by the organisers including any Health and Safety directions.

The Harbour Master reserves the right to remove any boat from its mooring prior to and/or during the gathering if, in his/her opinion, the need arises.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without cause assigned.

Please be aware of the health risks attached to boating, especially Weils Disease.

Information may in whole or in part be recorded on a computer in accordance with current data protection legislation.

All entrants must sign their entry form to show they agree to comply with and abide by these terms and conditions.
